

## **Application Documents**

- applicant's application (form attached);
- copies of the identity document (passport);
- a notarized copy of the document on the previous level of education (transcript if available);
- a medical certificate for a student traveling abroad, issued by the official health authority of the candidate's country of residence;
- a medical certificate confirming the absence of HIV infection & AIDS disease, issued by the official health authority of the candidate's country of residence;
- motivation letter in Kazakh/Russian or English;
- recommendation letter in Kazakh/Russian or English;
- a non-conviction certificate



# Q&A part about scholarship provided by Kazakhstan






#### Is a monthly scholarship provided for the proposed grant? What is the amount of the scholarship?

## Yes, we provide monthly scholarship

Bachelor	31,423KZT
Those with a major related to education	50,400KZT
Master	76,950KZT
PhD	172,500KZT

\*1 KZT = 2.78 KRW



#### Is dormitory provided?

Yes, you can apply for a dormitory. However, the dormitory fee must be paid by the student.

For foreign citizens,
payment for dormitories is
provided on the same basis
as payment for citizens of
Kazakhstan



I'd like to apply for a scholarship this time, is it only for tuition fees and monthly scholarships? Is there no financial aid for plane tickets or dormitory?

No, there is no other financial aid other than tuition fees and monthly scholarship.

-Dormitory fee, Plane ticket, Visa process, Insurance, Medical examination, Living expenses, etc. are **NOT** covered by the program.

## What language is the courses conducted?

The National University of
Kazakhstan offers courses in
Kazakh, Russian, and English,
but you need to clarify if the
courses is taught in English from
the university.



In case courses are provided only in Kazakh or Russian, are there any certification requirements for foreign citizens for proficiency in these two languages?

No, there is no required certificate of Kazakh/Russian proficiency.



# If language level is insufficient, is a language training course available?

The free language training period is one year. To apply for the language training, you **must fill out** an application for a one-year training in the language department when submitting the document.



# Are there any special requirements for the referee?

A former employer or university professor can write a recommendation letter.
